Students taking AP Biology, Calculus, Chemistry, Physics and/or Statistics should familiarize themselves with the calculators permitted on these exams and ensure that they have appropriate materials (information is in the AP Bulletin). All students taking an AP exam must complete pre-administration materials. Miss Curtin will be visiting study halls to facilitate this from April 21 to April 28.
