- Please remember that Re-registration is happening right now. If you need a new application please contact the office. Also, any family requesting financial aid must complete the Smart Tuition Financial Aid application on an annual basis. This is Diocesan aid and needs to be completed in order to be considered eligible for local sources of financial aid. Beginning in 2016/2017, the Smart Tuition Financial Aid application must be completed online. There are no paper forms available. Please read through the attached documents and note especially the due date for completion is March 18th. If you do not have access to a fax machine or need access to a computer, please contact the office to arrange a time to meet. In addition to Diocesan financial aid, Seton Catholic Central has numerous additional local sources of financial aid that may be available to families with children attending grades 7-12. Please review the first two pages of the attachment which provides information and requirements for each source. Complete the Seton Catholic Central Financial Aid form and return the completed form and return by Friday, March 18th.
