- PHILADELPHIA trip to the FRANKLIN INSTITUTE

On Friday February 5th, Ms. Schmidt and Mr. Monachino are taking students to see “Vatican Splendors” at the Franklin Institute. This exhibit is organized into 11 galleries with over 200 works of art and historically significant objects, many of which have never left the Vatican. Highlights include the evolution of the Church and the papacy beginning with St Peter through St Francis.

We will leave Seton at 6:30 for an 11:00 appointment at the exhibit. Lunch will be on your own at the Institute. We will have a tour of the historical area of Philadelphia in the afternoon and stop for dinner at the Allentown service plaza which offers several eating selections. We should return by 9:30. The cost for students is \$75 and adults are \$80. Ms. Schmidt’s art students and Mr. Monachino’s theology students are invited first to go. There is limited seating left on the bus.
