- The last local meet for Mathletes took place on March 8th, 2017. 1st place went to Vestal with a score of 23 and we came in a close second with a score of 21. Our Mathletes team has worked very hard and should be proud of their individual scores as well as the total team score. Out of the students from the 9 schools that have competed, the top 20 students will be selected to participate in a State Meet to be held on April 1st in Manhattan. Once all the schools have posted their individuals scores these students will be selected. Be assured that many of the Seton's team A students stand an excellent chance to be selected! - Hundreds of area tenth-graders will get a chance to explore some career options April 12 when dozens of business professionals gather at Binghamton University to demonstrate what they do for a living. Career Expo 2017, which runs from 9:30 a.m. to 1:40 p.m., will enable approximately 1,700 students from 16 Broome and Tioga county school districts to learn firsthand about a variety of potential career fields, ranging from culinary arts to computer networking, architecture to engineering. Each student will select two career presentations from about 40 options. The event is sponsored by Broome-Tioga BOCES, the Broome-Tioga Counselors Association, and Binghamton University. It was first conducted in 1993 in a cooperative effort by business and education to introduce students to the world of work.
